

ORDINANCE NO. 232 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF HART
CONSTRUCTION FOR THE PAVING, CURB & GUTTERS
AND STORM SEWER FOR PART OF HOLLYWOOD STREET
AND TO DECLARE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7) of all members elected
thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Hart Construction
being the lowest and best bid for the paving, curb and gutters,
and storm sewer of part of Hollywood Street, be and the same is
hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to
enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$10,146.50.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared
to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preserva-
tion of the public peace, property and welfare of the citizens
of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: To provide necessary utilities and
correct drainage problems and improve traffic conditions in
the City of Oberlin and shall take effect immediately upon
passage.
