

ORDINANCE NO. 234 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE CLEVELAND STREET &
CAROLINE STREET IN THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO

WHEREAS, on the 11th day of October, 1961, a petition by letter was made by all of the persons owning lots abutting on Cleveland and Caroline Streets in Follett's Addition to the City of Oberlin, praying that said streets be vacated and that notice of the filing of said petition was not required by law.

WHEREAS, Council upon hearing and being satisfied that there was good cause for such vacation as prayed for, and that it will not be harmful to the general public.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain and State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7) of those members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That Cleveland Street and Caroline Street in the City of Oberlin by and the same are hereby vacated.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the earliest period allowed by law.
