

ORDINANCE NO. 249 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF JANBY OIL CO.
FOR THE FURNISHING OF GASOLINE AT PUMPS AND TO
DECLARE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, five sevenths (5/7) of all members elected
thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the bid of Janby Oil Co. being the lowest
and best bid for the furnishing of gasoline at the pump, be and
the same is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby author-
ized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being:
Posted price less 7¢ per gallon

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to
be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preserva-
tion of the public peace, property and welfare of the citizens
of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: To provide for the motor vehicles
of the City and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
