

ORDINANCE NO. 251 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF SHALBY MUTUAL  
INSURANCE COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF MOTOR  
VEHICLE LIABILITY AND ALLIED COVERAGE AND TO  
DECLARE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,  
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7) of all members elected  
thereto concurring:


SECTION 1. That the bid of Shalby Mutual Insurance  
Company, being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of  
Motor Vehicle Liability and Allied Insurance be, and the same  
is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized  
to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being:  
\$1,417.62, minus any items deleted.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance is hereby declared to  
be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preserva-  
tion of the public peace, property and welfare of the citizens  
of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: To provide immediate insurance  
coverage protection for the motor vehicles of the City of  
Oberlin and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
