

ORDINANCE NO. 253 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 240 AC CMS
AND REJECTING BIDS RECEIVED FOR THE LEASING OF
CERTAIN LANDS OWNED BY THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin has heretofore authorized
the advertising for bids for the leasing of certain lands owned
by the City of Oberlin, Ohio.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City
of Oberlin, Ohio, five-sevenths of all members elected thereto
concurring:

SECTION 1. That all bids received under the advertisement
authorized by Ordinance No. 240 AC CMS are hereby rejected.

SECTION 2. That Ordinance No. 240 AC CMS and any pro-
ceedings therefrom and supplementary ordinances thereto are
hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public
peace, property and safety of the Citizens of Oberlin, Ohio,
to-wit: To expedite the re-development of the downtown area
of the City and to expedite the relief of traffic congestion
and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
