

**ORDINANCE NO 262 AC CMS**

**AN ORDINANCE ABANDONING THE CITY'S INTEREST IN  
A CERTAIN STORM SEWER IN THE CITY OF OBERLIN**

WHEREAS, in previous years, there has been in existence a storm sewer in the City of Oberlin approximately 115 feet westerly from South Main Street, and

WHEREAS, said storm sewer was constructed by parties unknown and has been connected to the City of Oberlin Storm Sewer System and

WHEREAS, said storm sewer is no longer in use

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Loran County Ohio a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

**SECTION 1** That the City does by the enactment of this Ordinance abandon, surrender and relinquish any right or claim that said City may have in a certain storm sewer located on the following described property:

**SITUATED IN THE CITY OF OBERLIN, County of Loran and State of Ohio, and being part of original lots Nos 234 and 235 and part of an unplatted portion of Original Township lot No 85**

Beginning at a catch basin located approximately 185 feet southerly from the centerline of College Street, and 125 feet westerly from the westerly line of South Main Street; thence in a southeasterly direction about 200 feet to a catch basin located in the centerline of Carpenter Court so called, and approximately 33 feet westerly from the westerly street line of South Main Street

**SECTION 2** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the earliest period allowed by law
