

ORDINANCE NO. 266 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF BECKSTEIN
ASPHALT AND PAVING COMPANY FOR STREET IMPROVE-
MENTS AND TO DECLARE THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, Lorain County,
Ohio, five-sevenths of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Beckstein Asphalt and Paving Co.
being the lowest and best bid for selected Street Paving Improvements
be and the same is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby
authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being:

\$6.30 per ton for 66 Stone
.17 per gallon for liquid asphalt
1.00 per sq. yd. for T-35

for a total cost not to exceed \$ 11,676.91.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the
public peace, prosperity and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio,
to-wit: To permit the safe and reasonable vehicular passage over the
street right-of-way.
