AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 240 AC CMS BY COMPORMING THE DESCRIPTION WITH THE ACTUAL SURVEY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT CRDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Chic, five-sevenths (5/7s) of all members elected thereto concurring:

as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 240 AC CMS now reading

"SECTION 1. That the following described real estate belonging in whole or in part to the City of Oberlin, Chie, to not presently needed for any numbers purpose, to-wit:
