

ORDINANCE NO. 284 AC CMS

ACCEPTING THE BID OF LINE MATERIAL INDUSTRIES
FOR FURNISHING OF APPROXIMATELY 134 FARGO TYPE
S-5 SPACERS FOR THE MUNICIPAL ELECTRIC DEPART-
MENT AND TO DECLARE THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County,
Ohio, five-sevenths of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Line Material Industries, being the
lowest and best bid for the furnishing of approximately 134 Fargo
Type S-5 Spacers, and the same is hereby accepted and the City
Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly,
the bid being \$5.90 each, total price being \$790.60.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the
safety, health and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:
To expedite the improvement of the Electric Light and Power System
of Oberlin, Ohio, and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
