

ORDINANCE NO. 297 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE CREATING STORM SEWER DISTRICT
NO. 1, IN THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO

WHEREAS, over the past several years, studies of the needs of the Storm Sewer System have been made in the City of Oberlin, Ohio, and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer of the City of Oberlin, after studying said storm sewer system, has recommended the establishment of a storm sewer district for part of the City of Oberlin.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the following described real estate

Situated in the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, and State of Ohio, and bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the center line of Pyle-South Amherst Road, distant 609.0 feet Northerly from the center line of Morgan Street; thence Westorly at right angles to Pyle-South Amherst Road a distance of about 1050.0 feet to the Westorly line of lands owned by Elizabeth Kelly; thence in the Westorly line of said lands, Northerly a distance of 1300.00 feet; thence Easterly at right angles to Pyle-South Amherst Road a distance of about 820.0 feet to a point 200.0 feet Westorly from the Westorly line of Pyle-South Amherst Road; thence Northerly parallel to said Road to the Southerly line of Lorain Street; thence in said Southerly line, Easterly to a point 200.0 feet Easterly from the center line of Pyle-South Amherst Road; thence Northerly parallel to Pyle-South Amherst Road a distance of 200.0 feet from the center line of Lorain Street; thence in the Northerly line of Oberlin City Corporation line, Easterly to the Westorly Corporation line of Oberlin City; thence in said Westorly line, Northerly to the Southerly line of Union Street; thence in said Southerly line, Easterly to the center line of an alley, distant 192.0 feet Easterly from the Easterly line of North Prospect Street; thence Southerly in said center line, 200.0 feet to a point; thence Easterly in a line parallel to Union Street to the center line of an alley 192.0 feet, Easterly from the Easterly line of Hollywood Street; thence in said center line Southerly 100.0 feet to a point; thence Easterly in a line 300.0 feet Southerly from the Southerly line of Union Street and parallel thereto to a point 272.25 feet Easterly from the Easterly line of Woodland Avenue; thence in a line parallel to Woodland Avenue, Southerly 145.0 feet to a point; thence Easterly in a line parallel to Union Street and 445.0 feet Southerly from the Southerly line of said street, to a point 220.0 feet Westorly from the Westorly line

of Main Street; thence Southerly parallel to Main Street 198.0 feet; thence in a line parallel to Union Street, Easterly to the Easterly line of Main Street; thence in the Easterly line of said Street, Southerly to the Southerly line of Vine Street; thence in said Southerly line, Westerly to the Easterly line of Professor Street; thence in said Easterly line, Southerly to a point 200.0 feet Southerly from the Southerly line of Forest Street; thence in a line parallel to and 200.0 feet Southerly from the Southerly line of Forest Street, Westerly to a point 434.0 feet Easterly from the Easterly line of Prospect Street; thence in a line parallel to Prospect Street and 434.0 feet Easterly therefrom; North-erly to a point distant 179.50 feet Northerly from the Northerly line of Forest Street; thence in a line parallel to Forest Street, Westerly to a point 150.0 feet Easterly from the Easterly line of Prospect Street; thence in a line parallel to Prospect Street, Northerly to a point 150.0 feet Southerly from the Southerly line of Elm Street; thence in a line parallel to Elm Street, Westerly to a point 200.0 feet Westerly from the Westerly line of Prospect Street; thence in a line parallel to Prospect Street, Northerly to a point 200.0 feet Northerly from the Northerly line of Elm Street; thence in a line parallel to Elm Street, Westerly to the Westerly line of the former Lorain-Ashland and Southern Railroad right-of-way; thence in said Westerly line, Southerly to a point 200.0 feet Northerly from the Northerly line of Morgan Street; thence in a line parallel to Morgan Street, Westerly to the former Westerly line of Oberlin Village; thence in said Westerly line, Southerly to the Southerly line of Oberlin Cemetery lands; thence Westerly to the Westerly line of Oberlin Cemetery lands; thence Southerly to Plum Creek; thence Westerly in said creek to a point 200.0 feet Easterly from the center line of Pyle-South Amherst Road; thence in a line parallel to said Road, Northerly to the center line of Morgan Street; thence Westerly in said center line to the center line of Pyle-South Amherst Road; thence Northerly in the center line of Pyle-South Amherst Road, 600 feet to the place of beginning of lands herein described,

being and the same is hereby established as a storm sewer district and shall be designated as City of Oberlin Storm Sewer District No. One.

SECTION 2. The City Engineer is hereby instructed to devise and form a general plan for said Storm Sewer District No. One with regard to the present and prospective interests of the City of Oberlin and report same to the Council when completed.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the earliest period allowed by law.
