

ORDINANCE NO. 308 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF TEXACO,
INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF LUBE OIL AND TO
DECLARE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, five sevenths of all members elected thereto
concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Texaco, Inc., being the lowest
and best bid for the furnishing of Lube Oil be, and the same is hereby
accepted and the Acting City Manager is hereby authorized to enter in-
to a contract accordingly, the bid being:

.435	per gallon
.415	per gallon-truck loads
.335	per gallon-tank car loads

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to
be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation
of the public peace, property, and welfare of the citizens of
Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: The continued operation of the municipal
light plant and shall take effect immediately upon passage.

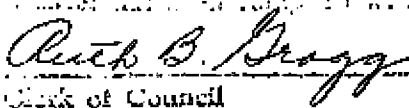
