

ORDINANCE NO. 310 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF HART
CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING
OF LIMESTONE AND ASPHALT AND TO DECLARE
SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, five sevenths of all members elected thereto
concurring:

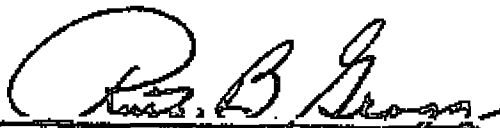
SECTION 1. That the bid of Hart Construction Company,
being the lowest and best bid for the furnish of Limestone and
Asphalt be, and the same is hereby accepted and the Acting City
Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly,
the bid being:

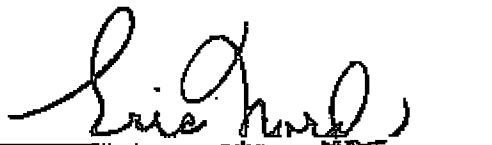
No. 6 Limestone	\$ 4.50 per ton
MC-5 Liquid Asphalt	.16 per gallon
MC-1 Liquid Asphalt	.15 per gallon
T-35 2 one inch courses laid	1.00 per sq. yd.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared
to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation
of the public peace, property, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin,
Ohio, to-wit: To keep the streets of the City in repair and shall
take effect immediately upon passage.
