

ORDINANCE NO. 311 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF B & W
TANK & STACK COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING
OF WATER TANK CLEANING, PAINTING & REPAIRING
AND TO DECLARE THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain
Lorain County, Ohio, five sevenths of all members elected thereto
concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of B & W Tank & Stack Company
of Union City, Indiana, being the lowest and best bid for the furn-
ishing of Water Tank Cleaning, Painting and Repairs be, and the same
is hereby accepted and the Acting City Manager is hereby authorized
to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being:

be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of
the public peace, property, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin,

ment and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
