

ORDINANCE NO. 316 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF GRIFFITH  
BLACKTOP, INC. FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF SMITH  
STREET AND TO DECLARE THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain  
County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7s) of all members elected thereto  
concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Griffith Blacktop, Inc. being the  
lowest and best bid for the improvement of Smith Street be, and  
the same is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby author-  
ized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$19,694.75.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency  
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:  
To provide for improvement and traffic conditions on Smith Street  
and necessary drainage therein and shall take effect immediately  
upon passage.
