

**ORDINANCE NO. 332 AC CMS**

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING NORTH PROSPECT STREET, FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH UNION STREET TO THE EXISTING ACCEPTED STREET AND CUL DE SAC FOR MAINTENANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

**SECTION 1.** That North Prospect Street, a duly dedicated street in the city of Oberlin, from its intersection with Union Street, southerly to the northerly line of the pre-existing paved street and cul de sac, be and the same is hereby approved and accepted. The dedication of the public use of the street herein as shown, is hereby accepted and confirmed and said street accepted for maintenance upon the furnishing of a maintenance bond in the amount of \$1,000.00.

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: To expedite the maintenance and clearing the streets of the City of Oberlin, and shall take effect immediately upon passage.


