

ORDINANCE NO. 309 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SALARY OF THE MUNICIPAL JUDGE OF THE OBERLIN MUNICIPAL COURT FOR THE TERM COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 1964 AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 25 AC CMS AND ORDINANCE NO. 203 AC CMS AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO,

five-sevenths (5/7s) of all members elected thereto concurring:

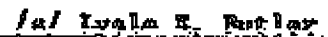
SECTION 1. That the salary of the Judge of the Municipal Court of the City of Oberlin, for the term commencing January 1, 1964, shall be \$7,200 per annum, payable semi-monthly, three-fifths (3/5ths) of said sum to be paid from the General Fund, and two-fifths (2/5ths) to be paid by Lorain County.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: to provide for the continued operation of the Municipal Court of the City of Oberlin and shall take effect immediately upon passage.

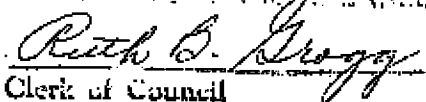
