ORDINANCE NO. 358 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AWARDING THE SALE OF THE SMITH STREET SPECIAL ASSESSMENT BONDS AND DECLARINGFAN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin has approved and authorized the issuance of special assessment bonds for the Smith Street Improvement in the amount of Sixteen Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$16,250.00), and

WHEREAS, said bonds have been offered to the Gager Fund, and whereas the fiscal officers in charge of said Gager Fund have determined to purchase said bonds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDA!NED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Localn County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7s) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the issue of bonds as determined previously in the amount of Sixteen Hundred Twenty Five Dollars (\$1625.00) each for ten (10) bonds at the rate of 3.75% both principal and interest payable annually. Authorization for the improvement of Smith Street is hereby awarded to the Gager Fund (Cemetery Endowment Fund).

SECTION 2. That the treasurer and auditor of the City of Oberlin are hereby directed to deliver said bonds to the Gager Fund upon receipt of Sixteen Thousand Two Mundred Fifty Dollars (\$16,250,00).

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: that the note of the City of Oberlin heretofore issued is about to meture and must be retired by the proceeds of this bond, and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
