

ORDINANCE NO. 363 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 575.03 REMOVAL
OF TREES, WEEDS, GRASSES BY MUNICIPALITY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County,
Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. Section 575.03 is hereby amended to read as follows:
"In the event the owner does not trim and/or remove any tree, weeds,
grass, plant and shrubbery, or any part thereof, in accordance with
the provisions of this chapter, then the city manager, if the owner
can be located, shall have the authority to have said owner cited into
court for said failure. If the owner cannot be located, the city
manager shall have the authority to have the tree, weeds, grass, plant,
shrubbery trimmed and/or removed and assess the cost against the real
estate."

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace,
safety, and welfare of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: in provid-
ing for the removal of trees, weeds, grass, plants, and shrubbery
injurious to the health of the citizens of Oberlin and shall be in
effect immediately upon passage.
