

ORDINANCE NO. 364 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE TO ABANDON USE OF A CEMETERY, AND TO DECLARE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County,

Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7) of all members elected thereto concurring:

It being recently discovered that certain land on Groveland Street in said city being used as a cemetery many years ago and the relatives of those interred therein being unknown,


SECTION 1. It is hereby directed that this land no longer be used as a cemetery and the Sexton of the present Westwood Cemetery is hereby directed to remove the bodies interred therein and bury them at Westwood Cemetery.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: the continued health and welfare of the city of Oberlin, and shall take effect immediately upon passage.


