

ORDINANCE NO. 366 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF HANNON MOTORS  
SALES FOR THE FURNISHING OF A TRUCK FOR THE  
CEMETERY DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN  
EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain  
County, Ohio, five-sevenths of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Hannon Motor Sales, Wellington,  
Ohio, being the lowest and best bid for furnishing a truck, be and the  
same is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to  
enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$2700.00.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an  
emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
peace, health, and safety of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:  
To provide for the continued operation of the Cemetery Department of  
the City of Oberlin and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
