

ORDINANCE NO. 367 AC CMS

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF ANDY SUPERS
FOR THE FURNISHING OF FLEET INSURANCE FOR THE
CITY OF OBERLIN-EMERGENCY**

BE IT ORDAINED by the council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain
County, Ohio, five-sevenths of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Andy Supers, Insurer, Oberlin,
Ohio, being the lowest and best bid for furnishing Fleet Insurance, be
and the same is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby author-
ized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$1121.36.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the
public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio,
to-wit: To provide proper and adequate insurance coverage for the
vehicles in the fleet of the City of Oberlin and shall take effect
immediately upon passage.
