

ORDINANCE NO. 369 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF MAINLAND SOHIO
FOR FURNISHING GASOLINE AND OIL, LUBRICATION AND
WASHING SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN VEHICLES,
AND TO DECLARE THE SAME AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County,
State of Ohio, five sevenths (5/7s) of all members elected thereto
concurring:


SECTION 1. That the bid of Mainland Sohio being the lowest and
best bid for the furnishing of gasoline and oil, lubrication and
washing services for the city of Oberlin vehicles for the balance
of the year 1964 and 1965, be and the same is hereby accepted, and
the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract ac-
cordingly, the bids being:


For gasoline, the posted price at the station less .08¢
Tank Truck price (bulk) less .08¢
Oil: quart price less discount #5%
Automobile washing \$1.50
Automobile lubrication \$1.50

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace,
property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:
The continued operation of the vehicles of the City of Oberlin and
shall take effect upon passage.
