

ORDINANCE NO. 371 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF THE AVON EXCAVATING  
COMPANY TO EXTEND THE WATER MAIN ON WEST LORAIN STREET  
AND TO DECLARE THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County,  
State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7s) of all members elected thereto  
concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Avon Excavating Company being the low-  
est and best bid for the extension of the water main on West Lorain  
Street 1000 feet west to the West College Street-West Lorain Street  
intersection be and the same is hereby accepted, and the city manager  
is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid  
being \$6,065.00 to include 1000 lineal feet of C.I.P.; 5 6" valves  
and boxes; 6" hydrant connections; 2 6" hydrants and valves; 0.5 ton  
C.I. fittings; 2 1/5 tons of stone backfill.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an  
emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace,  
property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:  
To provide for the continuous operation of the waterworks system  
of Oberlin, Ohio and shall take effect immediately upon passage.


