

ORDINANCE NO. 375 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 252 AC CMS ESTABLISHING
ADDITIONAL CROSSWALKS AND SIGNS FOR SAME IN THE CITY OF
OBERLIN, OHIO AND TO DECLARE THE SAME AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, additional crosswalks are deemed necessary for the safety of the
citizens of the City of Oberlin.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Oberlin, five-
sevenths of all members elected thereto concurring:

THAT Ordinance NO. 252 AC CMS is hereby amended to read:

SECTION 1. Pedestrian crosswalks are hereby established on South Main Street
just north of the Peoples Office of the Lorain County Savings and Trust Company, on
North Main Street near Hall Auditorium, on East College Street near T. O. Murphy Co.,
and on West College Street at its intersection with College Place, and additional
crosswalks on West Lorain Street in front of the Kettering Building and on East
Lorain Street approximately 300 feet east of Rowe Motor Sales and in line with the
school property, and on South Main Street just north of the City Hall and Post Office.

SECTION 8. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, and welfare
of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit: To provide for the orderly flow of
vehicular traffic and for the protection of pedestrians.
