

ORDINANCE NO. 377 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE DEDICATION  
OF THE STREETS IN WESTMOOR COLONY SUB-  
DIVISION NO. 2 AND THAT THE SAME BE  
DECLARED AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, there has been presented to the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, the Proposed Westmoor Colony Subdivision No. 2, Colony Drive, dedicated by the owners thereof as a public right-of-way, and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of the City of Oberlin has approved said Subdivision,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7s) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the dedication of Colony Drive as shown in the Proposed Westmoor Colony Subdivision No. 2 of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, is hereby accepted by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the earliest period allowed by law.
