

ORDINANCE NO. 383 AC CHS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER
INTO A CONTRACT WITH PITTSFIELD TOWNSHIP AND TO
DECLARE THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain
County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7s) of all members elected
thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. The proposed agreement for fire protection
between the City of Oberlin and Pittsfield Township of Lorain County,
Ohio, commencing January 1, 1965, for the year 1965, is hereby approved
and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract on
behalf of the City of Oberlin accordingly.

SECTION 11. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency
measure, the emergency being the preservation of the public peace,
safety, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: To
provide for the daily and orderly operation of the fire department
of the City of Oberlin, and shall take effect immediately upon
passage.
