

ORDINANCE NO. 386 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ORDERING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LORAIN COUNTY GENERAL HEALTH DISTRICT AND DECLARING THE SAME AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County and State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. The proposed agreement between the City of Oberlin and the Lorain County Board of Health, from January 1, 1965 to December 31, 1965, for the payment by the City of Oberlin of Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1200) a year for inspection of housing is hereby approved, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract between the Lorain County Board of Health and the City of Oberlin, accordingly.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, to-wit: To provide for the continued safe and healthful housing for the City of Oberlin, and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
