

ORDINANCE NO. 398 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF HANNON MOTOR
SALES FOR THE FURNISHING OF A PICKUP TRUCK AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Hannon Motor Sales being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of one pickup truck with the following specifications:

CHASSIS SPECIFICATIONS

New 1965 model to meet the following specifications:

- (1) Minimum 150 cu. in. engine or better
- (2) Front axle minimum, 2,500 lb. capacity
- (3) Rear axle minimum, 3,200 lb. capacity
- (4) Minimum 10" clutch
- (5) Minimum 4,000 G.V.W. or better
- (6) Two (2) electric windshield wipers
- (7) Directional signals
- (8) One (1) rear view mirror, standard
- (9) Fresh air heater and defroster with switch mounted on dash panel
- (10) Minimum 37 amp. alternator, 12 volt
- (11) Oil bath air cleaner full flow oil filter
- (12) Paint: Manufacturers Red (Baked Enamel or equal)
Black Wheels (Baked Enamel or equal)
- (13) Two (2) tires, rear wheels, mud and snow tread
Two (2) tires, front wheels, standard tread
One (1) tire and extra rim, standard tread
- (14) Transmission, 3 speed
- (15) Brakes, self adjusting hydraulic
- (16) Parking brake, control of rear brakes

The Bid Figure for the foregoing described vehicle will include Trade-in of 1953 truck; be and the same is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$1,600.00.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of said City, and for the further reason to continue the services necessary to said City:

WHEREFORE this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after immediately after its passage.
