

ORDINANCE NO. 404 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF
OHIO ENGINEERING FOR THE FURNISHING
OF BITUMINOUS CONCRETE FOR CITY PAVING
PROGRAM AND TO DECLARE SAME EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain
County, State of Ohio, five sevenths (5/7ths) of all members
elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Ohio Engineering being the lowest
and best bid for the furnishing of Bituminous Concrete for paving
program be, and the same is hereby accepted and the city manager
is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the
bid being \$21,385.00.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the
public peace, property, and welfare of the citizens of the City
of Oberlin.
