

ORDINANCE NO. 412 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF GENERAL
CHEMICAL COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF ALUM
AND TO DECLARE THE SAME AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7s) of all members
elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of General Chemical Company being
the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of Alum be, and the same
is hereby accepted and the city manager is hereby authorized to enter
into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$2.47 CWT.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be
an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of
the public peace, property, and welfare of the citizens of the
City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: To provide for the daily operation
of the municipal water department and shall take effect upon pas-
sage.
