

ORDINANCE NO. 415 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF GULF OIL
COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF FUEL OIL NO.2
AND TO DECLARE THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7s) of all members
elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of the Gulf Oil Company being
the best bid for the furnishing of Fuel Oil No. 2 be, and the
same is hereby accepted and the city manager is hereby authorized
to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$.0362 per
gallon.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be
an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of
the public peace, property and welfare of the citizens of the
City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: To provide for the daily operation
of the municipal light and power plant and shall take effect upon
passage.
