

ORDINANCE NO. 419 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF AVON LAKE EXCAVATING COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF LABOR & MATERIALS FOR LORAIN-PARK STREET STORM SEWER IMPROVEMENT AND TO DECLARE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Avon Lake Excavating Company being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of labor & materials for Lorain-Park Street Storm Sewer Improvement be, and the same is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$14,357.14.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property and welfare of the City of Oberlin, State of Ohio, to-wit: To provide storm sewerage facilities for the City of Oberlin.
