

ORDINANCE NO. 424 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF GENERAL
ELECTRIC COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF 2-WAY
RADIO EQUIPMENT AND TO DECLARE THE SAME AN
EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain
County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto
concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of General Electric Company
being the best bid for the furnishing of 2-way radio equipment
be, and the same is hereby accepted and the City Manager is
hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the
bid being \$4,243.50.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be
an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation
of the public peace, property, and welfare of the citizens of
the City of Oberlin, Ohio, and shall take effect upon passage.
