

ORDINANCE NO. 436 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING A FIRE CONTRACT
FOR PITTSFIELD TOWNSHIP AND TO DECLARE
THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all
members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the renewal agreement between the City
of Oberlin and Pittsfield Township providing that for Fire
Protection Pittsfield Township will pay the City of Oberlin
the sum of \$300.00 as a base rate which will include the first
two (2) fires during the year. After the first two (2) fires,
Pittsfield Township will pay \$75.00 for the first hour of each
fire and a rate of \$3.00 per man per hour after the first hour
be, and the same is hereby approved.

SECTION 2: The City Manager shall hereby be directed and
authorized to execute said agreement on behalf of the City of
Oberlin.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be
an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation
of the public peace, property and welfare of the citizens of
Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: To expedite interchange of Fire Equip-
ment Service in the event of an emergency and shall take effect
immediately upon passage.


