

ORDINANCE NO. 443 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ADDITIONAL DUTIES OF THE  
POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN.

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin has a fee simple title to certain real estate outside the corporate limits of the City of Oberlin, and

WHEREAS, said property represents a considerable financial investment, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Oberlin has determined that it is necessary to provide police protection for said property owned by the City of Oberlin.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That in addition to the duties prescribed by the laws of the State of Ohio, and other ordinances of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, it shall be an additional duty of the Police Department of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to patrol, inspect, and protect the real property owned by the City of Oberlin outside the corporate limits of the City of Oberlin, such patrolling, inspection, and protection to be determined by the Chief of the Police Department of the City of Oberlin.

SECTION 2. The Police Department of the City of Oberlin, shall respond to all calls for police assistance originating from the real property owned by the City of Oberlin.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the protection of the peace, safety, and welfare of the City of Oberlin and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
