

ORDINANCE NO. 452 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR COST OF
LIVING INCREASE IN SALARIES AND/OR
WAGES AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain
County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected
thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. In order to adjust to the cost of living increases
over the last several years, in addition to the regular compensation,
all full-time employees of the City of Oberlin are hereby granted a
five per cent (5%) increase in their salaries and/or wages under the
existing pay scale.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the
public peace, safety, and welfare of the City of Oberlin, Ohio,
and shall take effect immediately upon passage for the pay period
of February, 1966.
