AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF PLUMB CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR THE VINE STREET TO LOCUST STREET STORM SEWER IMPROVEMENT AND DECLARING SAME TO BE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the council of the city of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

To provide for storm sewer drainage and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
