

ORDINANCE NO. 454 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF PLUMB CONSTRUCTION
COMPANY FOR THE VINE STREET TO LOCUST STREET STORM
SEWER IMPROVEMENT AND DECLARING SAME TO BE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the council of the city of Oberlin, Lorain County,
State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto
concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Plumb Construction Company for the
installation of the Vine Street to Locust Street storm sewer improve-
ment is hereby accepted for \$7,650.50, and the city manager is hereby
authorized to enter into a contract for same.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,
safety, and welfare of the city of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

To provide for storm sewer drainage and
shall take effect immediately upon passage.
