

ORDINANCE NO. 455 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 448
AC CMS OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND DECLARING
SAME TO BE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the council of the city of Oberlin, Lorain County,
State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto
concurring:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 448 AC CMS is hereby amended
to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. Said committee shall consist of three members, two
of which shall be citizens of the city of Oberlin, and the third
an employee representative, none of same to be a member of the
city council of the city of Oberlin, and all to be selected
according to Section 3 of Ordinance No. 448 AC CMS."

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,
safety, and welfare of the city of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

To provide for an employee grievance
procedure and shall take effect immediately
upon passage.
