

ORDINANCE NO. 460 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 145.14
(d) AC CMS AND DECLARE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County,
State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto
concurring:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 145.14 (d) of the Codified Ordinances of
the City of Oberlin is hereby amended to read as follows:

(d) Fire truck drivers, upon completion of one year's
continuous employment, shall receive two weeks paid vacation,
and beginning in the calendar year in which the employee com-
pletes fifteen (15) years of service, he shall receive three
(3) weeks paid vacation. Employees in this classification,
upon completion of one (1) years continuous employment, shall
be eligible for additional paid vacation allowance in lieu of
holidays of six (6) consecutive calendar days."

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety,
and welfare to-wit:

To adjust the holiday pay of the fire department and
shall take effect immediately upon passage.
