## ORDINANCE NO. 464 AC CMS

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CODIFIED ORDINANCE NO. 1319.06 (a)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 1319.06 (@) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Oberlin is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(a) All streets shall be improved with pavements to an overall width in accordance with the following minimum dimensions:

Type of Street	Pavement Width
	From Back to Back of Curbs
Arterial	38 feet*
Collector	30 feet
Local & cul-de-sac	27 feet
Half Street	18 feet
Residential boulevard (each land)	18 feet

\*Thirty feet by subdivider, eight feet by City.

Provided, however, that the Planning Commission may approve plans for streets in the category of local or cul-de-sec of overall paving width of not less than 24 feet provided that said Planning Commission finds that:

- 1. The area to be served does not justify the 27 feet street width.
- 2. The traffic using said street is local.
- 3. The street will not in the future be used for an arterial or collector street.

Upon the installation of said streets in accordance with the Planning Commission's approval, the City Engineer shall certify same as completed in accordance with City specifications.

The Oberlin Street Classification Map shall be part of this Ordinance."

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
