## ORDINANCE NO. 473 AC CMS

## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EMPLOYMENT OF CITY PLANNING ASSOCIATES, INC., AND DECLARING THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary by the Council of the City of Oberlin to participate in the Urban Renewal Program of the Federal Government, and

WHEREAS, as a condition to such participation, it is necessary to implement and complete certain planning in order to qualify for said urban renewal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That City Planning Associates, Inc., be and they are hereby employed to prepare a survey and plan application for Urban Renewal according to their presentation on June 27, 1966, at a price not to exceed Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500), and the City Manager, Donald Marquis, is directed to enter into a contract accordingly.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, to-wit:

To improve the living conditions of said citizens and to provide for urban renewal participation,

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
