

ORDINANCE NO. 474 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF BECHSTEIN ASPHALT
& PAVING CO. FOR THE FURNISHING OF CHIP AND SEAL
PAVING AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected
thereto concurring:


SECTION 1. That the bid of Bechstein Asphalt & Paving Co.,
being the best and lowest bid for the furnishing of chip and seal
paving and being in the amount of \$4.25 per ton for #6 limestone,
.155 per gallon for M-C5 or M-C1, it is hereby accepted and the
city manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the
same.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be
an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of
the public peace, safety, and welfare of the city of Oberlin, Ohio,
to-wit: To repair streets in the municipality, and shall be in
full force and effect from date of passage.


