DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected
thereto concurring:


SECTION 1. That the bid of Plas Asphalt Corp. being the
best and lowest bid for the furnishing of T-35 asphalt and tack
coat and being in the amount of \$18.00 per cubic yard, it is hereby
accepted and the city manager is hereby authorized to enter into a
contract for same.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be
an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of
the public peace, safety, and welfare of the City of Oberlin, Ohio,
to-wit: To repair the streets in the municipality, and shall be
in full force and effect from date of passage.


