

ORDINANCE NO. 480 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF GRIFFITH BLACKTOP,  
INC., FOR THE FURNISHING OF PAVING, CURBS, GUTTERS,  
AND STORM SEWERS FOR LINCOLN STREET AND DECLARING  
SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County,  
Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Griffith Blacktop, Inc., being the best and  
lowest bid for the furnishing of Paving, Curbs, Gutters, and Storm Sewers  
for Lincoln Street, and being in the amount of \$63,540.55, is hereby  
accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a con-  
tract for same.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency  
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,  
safety and welfare of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: to improve the  
traffic, pedestrian, and health conditions on Lincoln Street and shall  
be in full force and effect from the date of passage.
