

ORDINANCE NO. 492 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF SALO TREE SERVICE  
FOR THE FURNISHING OF TREE REMOVAL SERVICE FOR THE  
CITY OF OBERLIN AND DECLARING THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County,  
Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Salo Tree Service being the lowest  
and best bid for the removal of trees from the City of Oberlin for  
1967 be and the same is hereby accepted, and the city manager is  
hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid  
being \$16.75 per hour per crew (regular) and \$23.75 per crew for  
emergency work.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an  
emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public  
peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio,  
to-wit: The removal of diseased, damaged or otherwise dangerous  
trees or parts of same and shall take effect immediately upon  
passage.
