ORDINANCE NO. 493 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF MAINLAND SOHIO FOR FURNISHING GASOLINE AND OIL, LUBRICATION AND WASHING SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN VEHICLES AND DECLARE THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County,

Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Mainland Sohio being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of gasoline and oil, lubrication and washing services for the city of Oberlin vehicles for 1967, be and the same is hereby accepted and the city manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bids being:

For gasoline (pump or tank)	Price less 8,25¢ discount Quart less 40% discount
Automobile Washing Automobile Lubrication	\$1.50 \$1.50

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: The continued operation of the vehicles of the city of Oberlin and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
