

ORDINANCE NO. 497 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING A FIRE CONTRACT  
FOR PITTSFIELD TOWNSHIP AND TO DECLARE  
THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the renewal agreement for 1967 between the City of Oberlin and Pittsfield Township providing that for Fire Protection Pittsfield Township will pay the City of Oberlin the sum of \$300.00 as a base rate which will include the first two (2) fires during the year. After the first two (2) fires, Pittsfield Township will pay \$75.00 for the first hour of each fire and a rate of \$3.00 per man per hour after the first hour be, and the same is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. The City Manager shall hereby be directed and authorized to execute said agreement on behalf of the City of Oberlin.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

To expedite interchange of Fire Equipment Service  
in the event of an emergency and shall take effect  
immediately upon passage.
