

ORDINANCE NO. 498 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF ROWE MOTOR
SALES FOR THE FURNISHING OF A POLICE CRUISER
AND DECLARE THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County,
State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto
concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Rowe Motor Sales being the lowest
and best bid for the furnishing of a police cruiser be and the same
is hereby accepted and the Acting City Manager is hereby authorized
to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$2,267.90.


SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the
public peace, property, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin,
Ohio, to-wit:

To continue the necessary operation of the
Police Department and shall take effect immedi-
ately upon passage.
