

ORDINANCE NO. 514 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE RECOMMENDATION OF
THE PLANNING COMMISSION CONCERNING AN APARTMENT
HOUSE ON WEST COLLEGE STREET IN THE CITY OF OBERLIN,
OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County,
Ohio, five sevenths of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Oberlin Planning Commission's recom-
mendation concerning the Gaeuman Apartments on West College Street,
Oberlin, Ohio, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. That a zoning certificate is hereby ordered
issued by the Acting City Manager for said construction.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be and is hereby declared
to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation
of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City
of Oberlin, Ohio and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
